CHRISTMAS PARCEL SCAM

Be on your guard over a scam involving a card being posted through your door claiming to be from The Parcel Delivery Service (PDS). The card explains how they were unable to deliver a parcel and advise you to phone a premium rate number to re-arrange a delivery. However, once you call the number and are connected to a recorded message you are automatically charged £300 or a similar amount.
